**Would you be interested in helping your village community?
Graveley Parish Council has two vacancies for councillors.**

We meet once a month, for about half an hour, and councillors are sent an agenda and supporting documents - and are expected to consider them before the meeting (which generally takes another half an hour).

At each meeting, usually the third Tuesday of each month, at 8pm in the village hall, councillors work through the agenda and vote on things like local planning issues, expenditure and how we raise money via the precept on the council tax.

Once in a while, members of the public will attend and express their feelings about particular developments locally - and we listen to them and decide what we can do to help.

Councillors all bring their own skills and experience to the task, some take special interest in things like the playground, or planning matters.
